THE HOLY SPIRIT WORKS

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, in celebrating the Solemnity of Pentecost today, we celebrate the birth day of the Catholic Church and the working of the Holy Spirit in the Catholic Church from the times of the Apostles till today. Today the Catholic Church is born and this Catholicity, which means, “Universal” is in the Divine plan of God. “Why?” It is because God sent the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles in form of the tongues of fire and at the time when there were many people from various nations who had come to worship in Jerusalem. Indeed, the Holy Spirit came upon them in tongues of fire for they were going to proclaim the saving message of salvation by means of the Word that was pronounced by the tongue. They were also being empowered by the Holy Spirit. The Catholic aspect of the Church is evident on the day of Pentecost because of the many nationalities present. Though they were many, they all understood the proclamation of the Good News by the Apostles.

In the Old Testament, due to human pride, the people wanted to construct the Tower of Babel so as to reach God and also to make a name for themselves. Indeed, we read, “Come, let us build ourselves a city, and a tower with its top in the heavens, and let us make a name for ourselves; otherwise we shall be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth” (Genesis 11:4). FIRST READING

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles
2:1-11

When Pentecost day came round, the apostles had all met in one room, when suddenly they heard what sounded like a powerful wind from heaven, the noise of which filled the entire house in which they were sitting; and something appeared to them that seemed like tongues of fire; these separated and came to rest on the head of each of them.

SECOND READING

"The fruit of the Spirit"

A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Galatians 5:16-25

If you are guided by the Spirit you will be in no danger of yielding to self-indulgence, since self-indulgence is the opposite of the Spirit, the Spirit is totally against such a thing, and it is precisely because the two are so opposed that you do not always carry out your good intentions. If you are led by the Spirit, no law can touch you. When self-indulgence is at work the results are obvious: fornication, gross indecency and sexual irresponsibility; idolatry and sorcery; feuds and wrangling, jealousy, bad temper and quarrels; disagreements, factions, envy; drunkenness, orgies and similar things.

I warn you now, as I warned you before: those who behave like this will not inherit the kingdom of God. What the Spirit brings is very different: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness,

trustfulness, gentleness and self-control. There can be no law against things like that, of course. You cannot belong to Christ Jesus unless you crucify all self-indulgent passions and desire.

Since the Spirit is our life, let us be directed by the Spirit.

This is the word of the Lord.

"The Spirit of truth will lead you to the complete truth."

A reading from the holy Gospel according to John 15:26-27; 16:12-15

Jesus said to his disciples:

'When the Advocate comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father. the Spirit of truth who issues from the Father, he will be my witness.

And you too will be witnesses, because you have been with me from the outset, I still have many things to say to you but they would be too much for you now.

But when the Spirit of truth comes he will lead you to the complete truth, since he will not be speaking as from himself but will say only what he has learnt; and he will tell you of the things to come. He will glorify me, since all he tells you will be taken from what is mine.

Everything the Father has is mine; that

is why I said:

All he tells you will be taken from what is mine.'

to division and misunderstandings due to the various languages. These misunderstandings are overcome by the working of the Holy Spirit who unites all the people in the Profession of one faith. St. Paul would thus later on write, "There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all and through all and in all" (Ephesians 4:4-6). This unity is to be striven for by all the Christians and so the Blessed Apostle exhorts us thus, "make every effort to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace" (Ephesians 4:3).

Mother Church dedicates her Year B to the Sacraments. We are in this Year B. In the Seven Sacraments, we experience

the working of the Holy Spirit who sanctifies us. The Sacraments, therefore, are not empty rituals but rather are channels of God's life of grace into our souls. In each and every Sacrament, that we celebrate, we receive the Holy Spirit. It is therefore wrong for some people to claim that the Holy Spirit is not present in the Church. The Holy Spirit is present and active in the Church in many ways, among which are the Word of God, the Sacraments, Prayer, and the Life of grace.

The Holy Spirit is present and active in the Church. The existence of the Catholic Church from the times of the Apostles till today cannot be due to human creativity but due to the work of God. Indeed, the learned Gamaliel once said, "Fellow Israelites, consider

carefully what you propose to do to these men ... So in the present case, I tell you, keep away from these men and let them alone; because if this plan or this undertaking is of human origin, it will fail; but if it is of God, you will not be able to overthrow them; or else you may even be found fighting against God" (Act 5:35, 38-39). Jesus Christ Himself stresses that the Holy Spirit will guide the Church into all the Truth. He says, "I have much more to tell you, but now, it would be too much for you to bear. When, however, the Spirit comes, who reveals the truth about God, He will lead you into all the truth" (John 16:12-13).
